

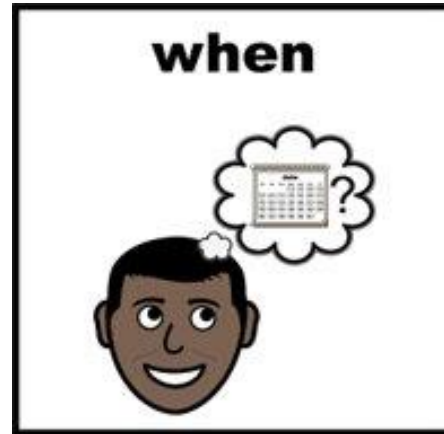
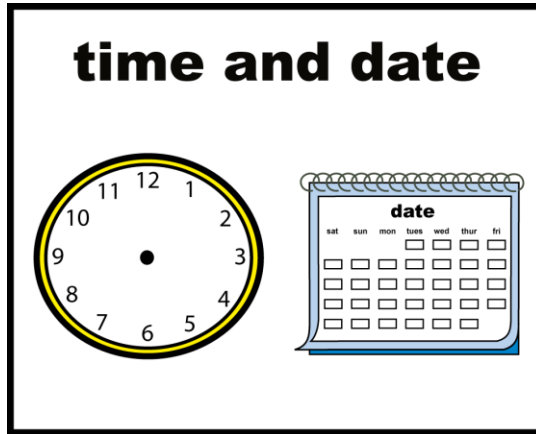

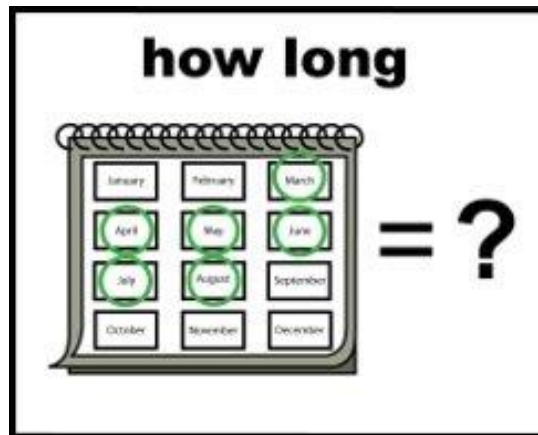
Easy Read: Freedom Festival 2023

A free outdoor festival of art, circus and music

When is it?



- Activities at Freedom Festival will take place between Wednesday 30th August and Sunday 3rd September.
- Most activities will take place on the **2nd and 3rd September between 10am and 8pm each day.**



- You don't have to stay the whole time.

Where is it?



- Freedom Festival will happen across the city centre.
- Places like Zebedee's Yard, Princes Dock Street and Trinity Square will have lots of shows and activities.
- The numbers on the map match the locations in the programme.

How to get there:



- Most buses run until 11pm every night.
- Paragon Interchange bus station is about a fifteen-minute walk to most festival sites.
- You can get a taxi from Drive or Hull Cars, or there are taxi ranks, including on Princes Dock Street, Alfred Gelder Street and Lowgate.
- Blue badge parking bays are located on Market Place, Hull, **HU1 1RR**.

Accessible Toilets

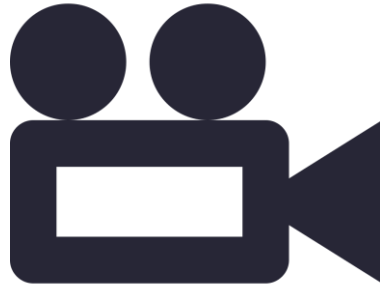


- RevoLOotion will be in Zebedee's Yard from Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd September.

Photography and filming

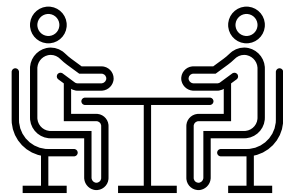
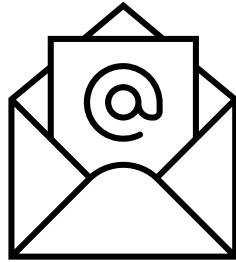
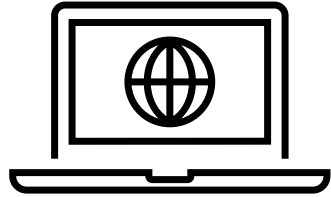


- We have photographers and film makers at events to capture footage to share online and for use in future.
